

Who We Are

Nashville Electric Service (NES) is the operating name of the Electric Power Board of the Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County. We are one of the 12 largest public utilities in the nation, serving more than 460,000 customers with annual revenues of approximately \$1.5 billion.

NES is overseen by a five-member board, appointed by the mayor and confirmed by the Metro Council. Board members serve five-year staggered terms without pay, set all policies and have full responsibility for the operation of NES.
